Chairman's Report 2016 – 2017

A very productive year with activities undertaken for the Neighbourhood Plan.

Notably –

- Green spaces application for the fields next to the village hall adopted into Mendip's updated Local Plan
- Lottery funds obtained for a comprehensive village housing questionnaire which produced a 41% response and extremely valuable comments and statistical information.

The village Flood Plan was finalised and flood prevention/remedial work was initiated and undertaken for a range of householders.

The two village defibrillators were finally installed, one in the BT 'phone box and one at the entrance to the village hall.

The e-mail register of parishioners is now being used to update on village events and warnings of road works and other matters that may impact village life.

In addition, the day to day monitoring of the safety and general maintenance of our village continues.

One councillor resigned, Gail Parker who has been a supportive village representative. She was replaced by Rina May.

We have been supported by the hard work and dedication of the Parish Clerk, Richard Ashworth, and it is with regret that we have received his wish to relinquish the role. He has served the Parish for 13 years and his knowledge has been an invaluable resource.

Gratitude also needs to be given to all the councillors who continue to work hard and productively on behalf of Croscombe and its residents.
